

Sialkot DPO punishes police officials

SIALKOT: District Police Officer (DPO) Chaudhry Nisar Ahmed Saroya has terminated the services of several police officials for negligence.

Mr Saroya also demoted Sub-Inspector Rana Muhammad Aslam to Assistant Sub-Inspector because he failed to recover items stolen in a robbery case, demoted Head Constable Muhammad Arshad to constable and reduced the pay of Constable Falak Bari for absence from duty.

Head constables Khalid Mehmood and Muhammad Nawaz and Constable Muhammad Mansha of the Sambrial Police Station have been demoted while Police Lines constables Ihsan Ullah and Ansar Ali have been terminated.

Mr Saroya has demoted Sub-Inspector Zulifqar Warriach of the Sadar Police Station to assistant following a poor investigation in a murder case. Sub-inspector Mushtaq was demoted to assistant sub-inspector of the Badiana Police Station for delaying a case under investigation.

Head Constables Abdul Razzaq and Shamoan Khan of the Sambrial Police Station were demoted to constables, Assistant sub-inspector Nasarullah of the Sambrial Police Station, Sub-inspector Muhammad Nawaz of the Kotli Police Station, Assistant Sub-inspector of the Kotli Police Station Loharan Muhammad Tufail, Assistant Sub-inspectors Muhammad Aslam and Miand Bshir of the Qilla Police Station, Assistant Sub-inspector Muhammad Nawaz of the Qila Kalarwala Police Station, Kotli Police Station Inspector Syed Amir, Sub-inspector Muhammad Ashraf of the Sambrial Police Station, Assistant Sub-inspector Amanat Ali of the Hajipura Police Station, Assistant Sub-inspector Gulzar Ahmed of the Motra Police Station, Sub-inspector Mushtaq Wahala and Sub Inspector Zafar Iqbal were reprimanded for various charges. He also reduced the pay of Assistant Sub-inspector Ikhlaiq Ahmed of the Police Station Kotwali.

Youth's body found in canal: The dead body of a young man was found in the Marala Ravi Link Canal after he was missing for four days. Ali Raza, Mohammad Ihsan's son, went to his in-laws' home in Bilal Colony in Mokhal Pulli Village and never returned. His father asked his relatives about his son's whereabouts. Raza's body was found in the canal. Police registered a case.

Four sentenced to die: Additional Sessions Court Judge Tariq Mehmood Iqbal Khan has sentenced to death Zafar, Asif alias Asa, Abdullah and Asif alias Papu for involvement in a double murder. The convicted men murdered their accomplices Muhammad Naeem and Farooq during a robbery in Dagree Hariyan Village after gang members had a fight over money. Mr Naeem and Mr Farooq were shot and burnt by the convicted men.

Drug peddler sentenced: Additional Sessions Court Judge Chaudhry Muhammad Rafique has sentenced Nasir Mehmood to hard labour and fined him Rs 25,000 for selling drugs.

Murderer jailed for life: Additional Sessions Court Judge Nazir Ahmed has sentenced Jamshed in prison for his involvement in a murder case in Nole Village.

Man charged in drug case: Khalid Mehmood was sentenced to 35 days hard labour and fined Rs 1,000 in a drug case.

New Ikhbar Faroosh Union chief: Ikhbar Faroosh Union President Chaudhry Abdul Karim has resigned. Union Chief Patron Chaudhry Iqbal accepted his resignation.

The Union's chief patron has named former general secretary Nazir Ahmed Baghi as the new president.
